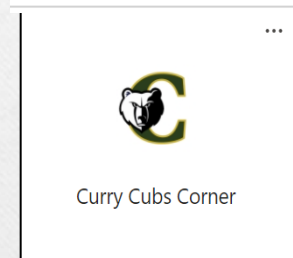

These programs satisfy student educational interest and mandated learning goals while promoting diversity.

Some programs accept **all interested** students; other programs have **specific** entrance criteria.

When the number of eligible students exceeds the number of available seats in non-audition-based or language tested Magnet programs, a random selection procedure is utilized to admit students.

- Visual & Performing

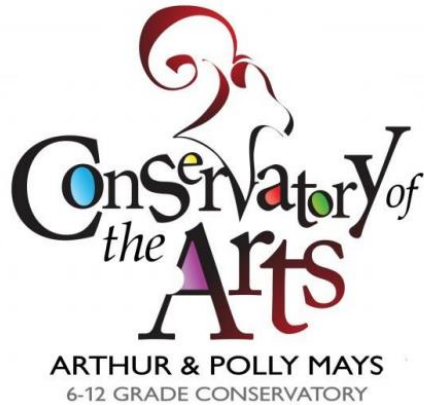
