## World History \& Career Planning $8^{\text {th }}$ gd. Course



Per Section 1003.4156, Florida Statutes (F.S.), for students to meet middle grades promotion requirements, a Career and Education Planning course must be completed. At a minimum, the course must be Internetbased, customizable to each student and include researched-based assessments to assist students in determining educational and career options and goals. (2019)

- All $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students MUST complete and submit their Education Plan.
- This is a Promotion Requirement


8th grade World History teachers will guide students through an exploration of the career modules found in My Career Shines, the online format approved by the Florida Department of Education for students to use to explore careers and create a career plan.
*2 interests inventory completed in Social Studies
*1 Career Plan mandatory for Graduation

Middle School Counselors will assist students create their Education Plans.
