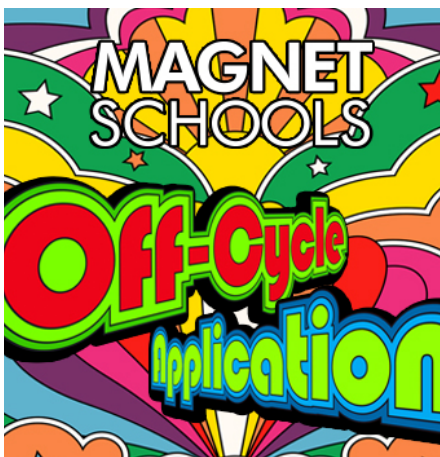

The Miami-Dade County Public Schools Off-Cycle Magnet Application period opened on Wednesday, April 13, 2022, to provide students another opportunity to apply for Magnet

seats for next school year. The Off-Cycle application period will remain open through the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

Students must apply and meet all eligibility criteria to be admitted and accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Accepting an Off-Cycle Magnet seat will not affect your wait-list status at another school.

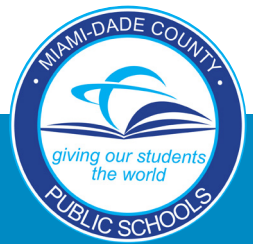
The Summer Youth Internship Program (SYIP) – a partnership between Miami-Dade County Public

Schools (M-DCPS), CareerSource South Florida, The Children’s Trust, Miami-Dade County, the EdFed Educational Federal Credit Union and the Foundation for New Education Initiatives – has officially kicked off for 2022. Entering its 7th consecutive year, SYIP connects rising 10th- through 12th-grade M-DCPS students (ages 15-18) with local businesses for a mutually beneficial workforce experience, July through August 2022.
