-Observed broken door gasket at double-door Continental R2 refrigerator, PC#1001310/TAG#1003664. Repair/replace door gasket.

-Observed out-of-order kettle with "Do Not Operate" tag. Repair/replace kettle, PC#1001773/TAG1003676. Per PIC, there is a work order in place.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.

Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting

-Replace burned-out light (1 of 2 bulbs) inside 3-door Continental refrigerator (R1), PC#1001311. [This is a repeat violation from last routine inspections 07/13/22 & 10/31/22]

-Replace burned-out light inside passthru single-door Traulsen refrigerator, TAG#1003656.[This is a repeat violation from last routine inspection 10/31/22]

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
